

**ADDITIONAL AGREEMENT TO
THE VIENNA AGREEMENT
CONCLUDED BETWEEN THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ADMINISTRATIONS OF
BELGIUM
THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY
FRANCE
LUXEMBOURG
THE NETHERLANDS**

PREAMBLE

The representatives of the telecommunications administrations of Belgium, the Federal Republic of Germany, France, Luxembourg and The Netherlands have concluded the present additional agreement to the Vienna Agreement with a view to adapt the latter to the special conditions in their common border areas.

1. AMENDMENTS TO THE VIENNA AGREEMENT 1993

The following annexes of the Vienna Agreement, 1993, have been adapted by the administrations signing the present additional agreement :

1.1 Annex 1

The table shall be replaced by the following one:

1.2 Annex 4

1.2.1 To determine the propagation over water, the cold sea curves shall be used after the transition period defined in point 13.2 of the Vienna Agreement of 1993.

1.2.2 During the transition period defined in point 13.2 of the Vienna Agreement 1993, the land propagation curves mentioned in annex 4 of the Vienna Agreement 1993 shall be used even for propagation over water.

2. REVISION OF THE ADDITIONAL AGREEMENT

This additional agreement may be expanded or amended at any time at the proposal of any signatory administration, subject to approval by the other signatory administrations.

3. WITHDRAWAL FROM THE ADDITIONAL AGREEMENT

Each administration may withdraw from the additional agreement by the end of a calendar month by giving notice of its intention at least six months before.

4. ENTRY INTO FORCE OF THE ADDITIONAL AGREEMENT



5. LANGUAGES OF THE ADDITIONAL AGREEMENT


This additional agreement is made out in three originals in the German, French and English language, each version being equally authentic.
