Context: preparation of the 2027-2029 Strategic Plan

In accordance with its legal tasks, the BIPT draws up a strategic plan **every three years** to submit to the Chamber of Representatives.

The current 2024-2026 Strategic Plan expires at the end of 2026. The BIPT will therefore start its **preparations for the 2027-2029 Strategic Plan**.

First, the BIPT organises a **call for input** to gather insights and priorities of the various stakeholders. This consultation takes place against a backdrop of:

- recent developments in the electronic communications market,
- developments at European level (legislation and strategic agendas),
- amendments to the Belgian regulatory and policy framework.

The **target audience** includes all economic players on the regulated markets (operators, providers, interest groups, user representation), as well as institutions and public sector organisations the BIPT cooperates with on a structural basis.

Following the analysis of the input received, the BIPT will publish a **draft Strategic Plan** for public consultation **in the autumn**.

The **final 2027-2029 Strategic Plan** will be adopted in **December 2026**.
